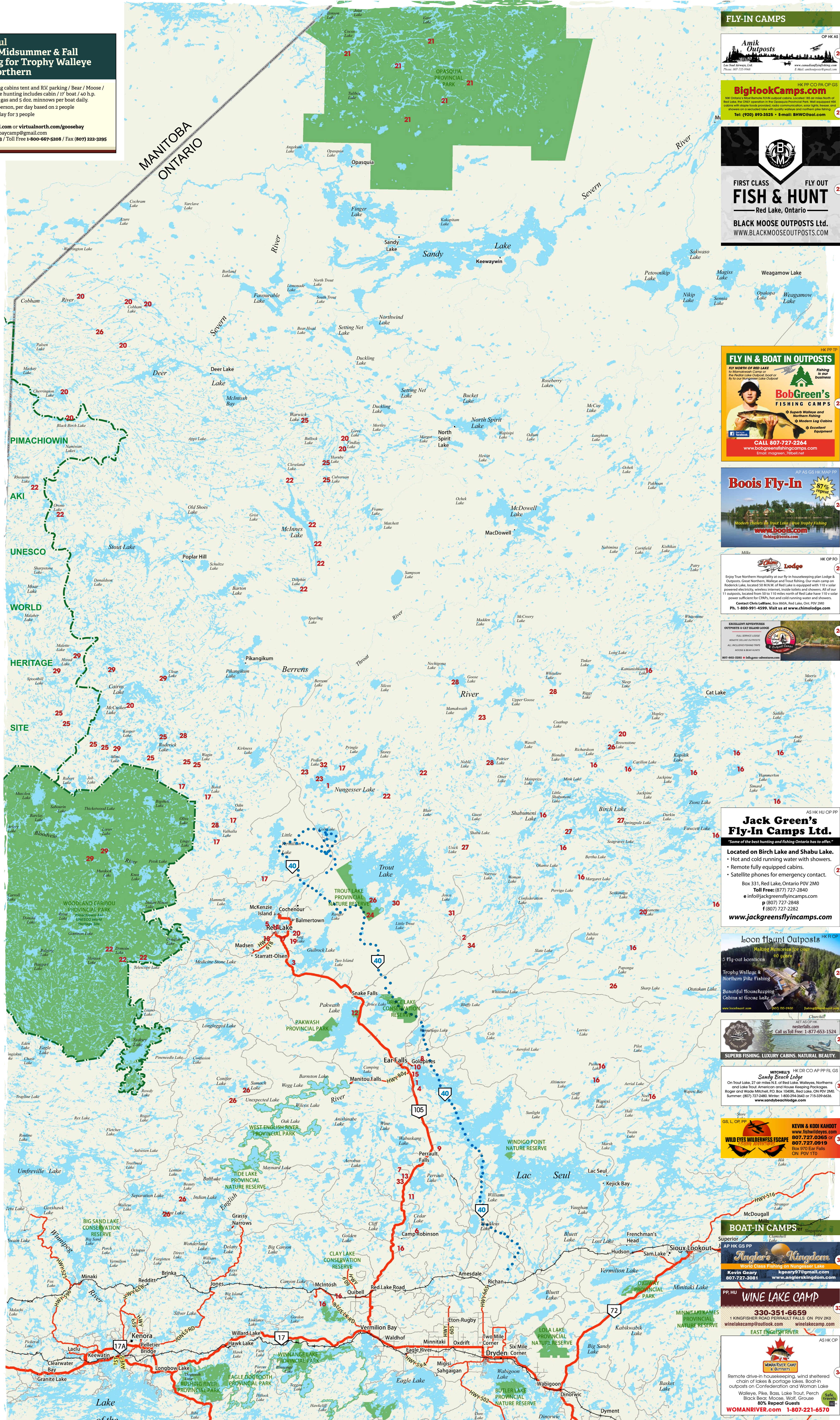

**FOREST FIRE SAFETY**

IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP FIRE SAFETY IN MIND. Fires should be built on bare rock or bare mineral soil and kept away from all flammable materials. When done with your fire, drown your fire thoroughly, stir the ashes, and drown it again to ensure that it is out. The use of portable camp stoves is highly recommended at all times and is mandatory in a Restricted Fire Zone (RFZ) where open fires are prohibited.

Unchecked campfires can lead to wildfires. These are destructive forces of nature that also have the potential to cause great damage to the bush and the communities located around the bush. Wildfires can be difficult to predict and to fight.

The local Anishinaabe people understood the importance of fire, easily identified by their language and stories. The indigenous peoples that lived in the area studied various types of fires and their reactions to various weather conditions. This allowed for a deeper understanding of how fire can be useful for their survival, and the importance of preventing uncontrolled burns in the forest.
